This app is what the school uses for all of their communication to our families and school community. All Permission notes for activities and excursions, along with requests for payment are sent out via this app, as are regular broadcasts with any relevant daily information. All payments for excursions are also made, quickly and simply, via the app.

The admin staff will provide you with a code that you can use to access information for your child at our school and are more than happy to help you if you're having any difficulty with the app.

Our handy tips for parents are to keep the Sentral Parent app on their front phone screen so that they see any notifications when they open their phone. We also suggest keeping your notifications for the app on at all times to prevent you from missing any important information!

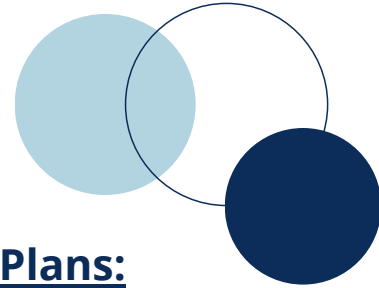


Our School Programs

Innovative Teaching and Learning:



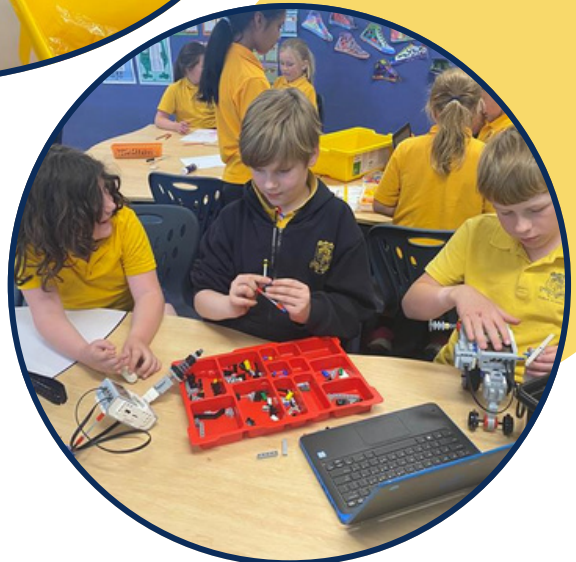
With a focus on action learning we aim to develop authentic opportunities for student voice that empowers students to be active learners.

Family-school partnership:

At Cooma PS, families, the school and community actively work together as partners to support learning, development and wellbeing of students. This partnership is developed through:

Bingitj Boorai's:

At Cooma PS we have created a safe space to give student voice, support and friendship to our Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students. Our Bingitj Boorai's - meaning cheeky child in Ngarigo language meet fortnightly to learn about and immerse themselves in cultural activities and focus on improving student outcomes.



Play based learning:

Children are naturally curious! At Cooma PS we recognise the need for students to learn about the world around them through watching, listening, moving, talking, feeling, exploring and questioning. These interactions and experiences often involve play. Through using play based learning our students can discover their own interests and abilities and imagine, investigate and explore!

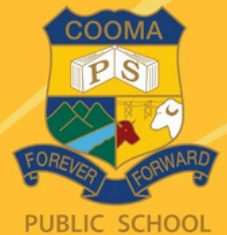

EVERY MINUTE AT SCHOOL COUNTS



When your child misses just...	that equals...	which is...	and therefore, from Kindy to Year 12, that is...
10 minutes a day	50 minutes of learning each week	Nearly 1½ weeks per year	Nearly ½ a year of school
20 minutes a day	1 hour and 40 minutes of learning each week	Nearly 2½ weeks per year	Nearly a year of school
½ hour a day	½ a day of learning a week	4 weeks a year	Nearly 1 ½ years of learning
1 hour each day	1 whole day of learning each week	8 weeks per year or nearly a term a year.	Over 2 ½ years of learning

Our school uniform consists of:
