




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Communication with the school

- To be treated fairly. Tolerance and understanding are promoted as we respect diversity.



Bingitj Boorai's:



Personalised Learning Plans:




Every student at Cooma PS is known valued and cared for. Each student has a meaningful education program that encourages student voice to allow every student to engage and take part in their learning.
