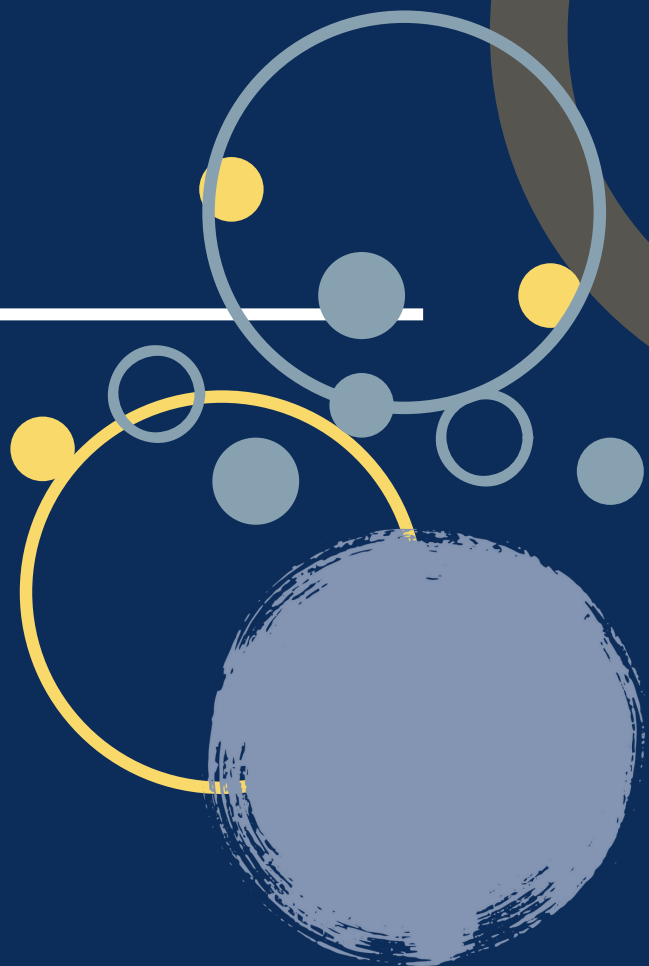

COOMA PUBLIC SCHOOL MUSICAL

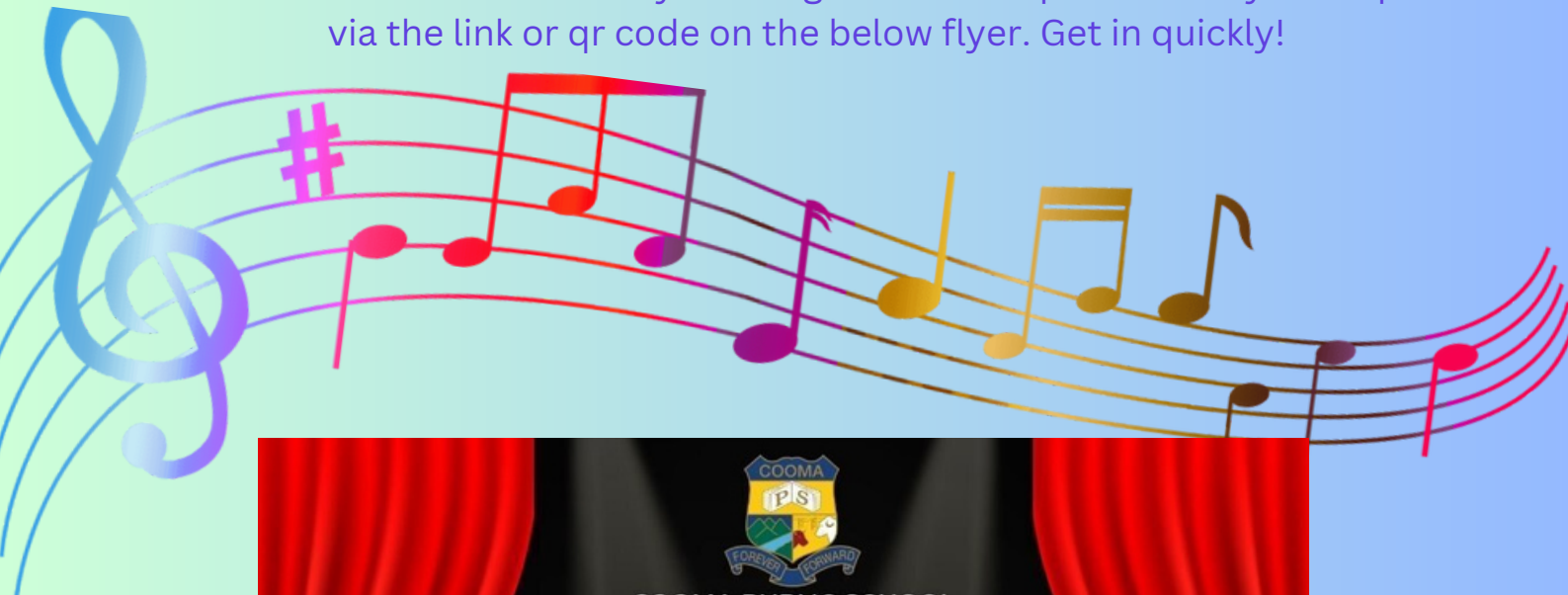
We are very excited to tell you that in week 10 of this term, Thursday 21st September, we will be holding a whole school musical performance!

KEY WORD SIGN

Key Word Sign is a tool or strategy which can be used to support children and adults with communication difficulties to understand and get their message across to others. Key Word Sign (KWS) adds signs to spoken words.

Key Word Sign whilst being similar to Auslan (sign language), focuses on just the "key" words in a sentence.

Given that we have several students who are non-verbal, we thought it would be a wonderful idea to each fortnight, share some signs with our entire school community and encourage everyone to try and learn some!

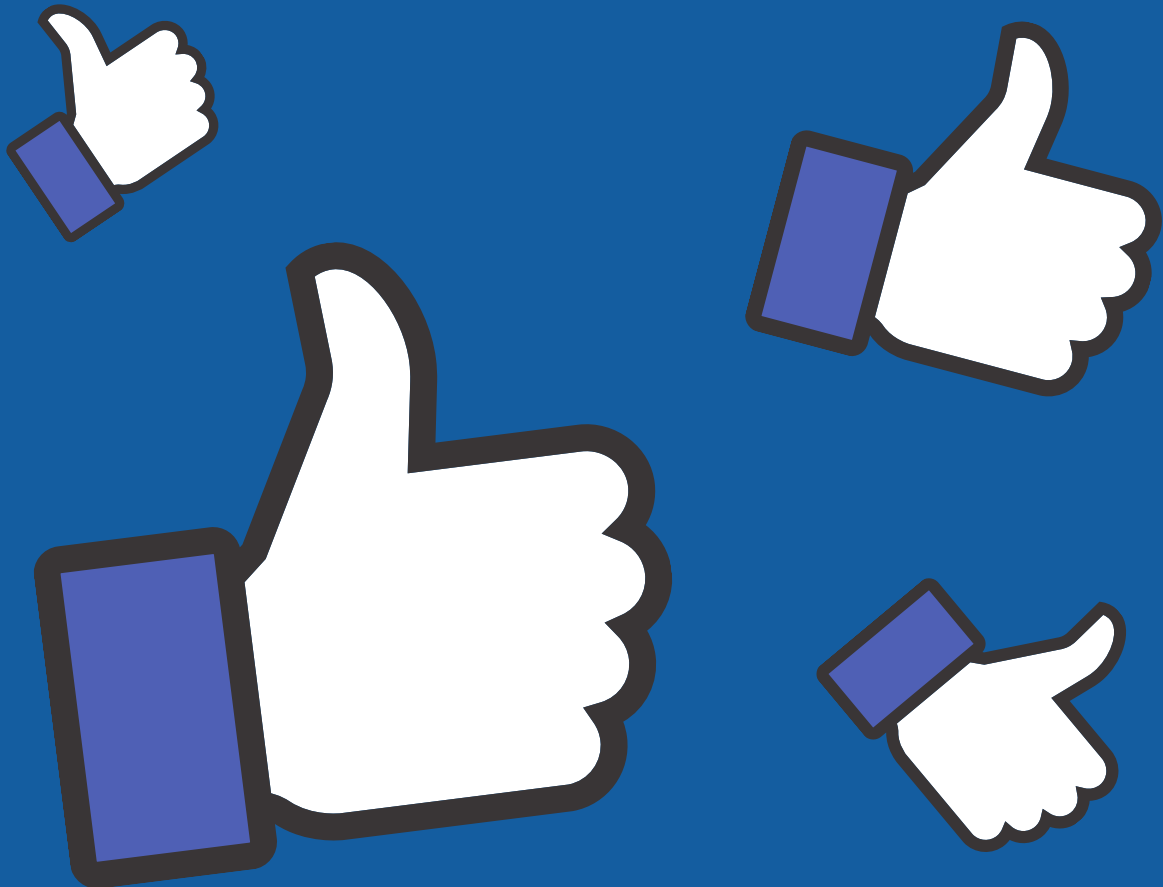
Close dominant fingertips onto ball of thumb. Tap formation on chin, twice.
